PRESIDENT'S REPORT ROUND 2 29th April 2009

In tying conditions Old Camberwell kicking with the wind in the first quarter it was Aaron Lord who kicked the first goal in his first game for the club. After again a couple of injuries to key players in the first quarter we were down to 2 on the bench. The boys had a great 2nd quarter kicking into the wind and found ourselves in front at the long break. Coming out after halftime Old Haileybury kicked some early goals in the 3rd quarter to put themselves in front at the last break, having the wind in the last quarter they ended up being too strong on the day. Our better players **W.Carlyle (4 goals)**, **McGuigan** was solid down back along with **DeSanctis** on Hampton. **Daniel Morley** played a solid game down back on Baptist. **Hendrie** and **Clarke** battled hard all day. Let's all stay positive and make sure all players including injured get to training this week".
